

Labs and Classrooms

Information Technology maintains 23 computer labs on campus. Of those, eleven Windows and two Macintosh labs are scheduled or staffed by the IT Help Desk. IT also provides staff and assistance to the Blackwell Library public computers. All software required to complete Salisbury University coursework is available in at least one lab, and usually in multiple labs: see our [Lab Software Configuration](#) document for the full list of software available. In addition the labs give students access to university printers and to central data storage (P: drives, K: drives).

- [Lab Hours](#) - See current and upcoming hours for the IT labs and Help Desk as well as viewing the current week's schedule for all IT labs. Updated on Fridays. Note that the schedule only contains schedules for labs which have an active class or event scheduled.
